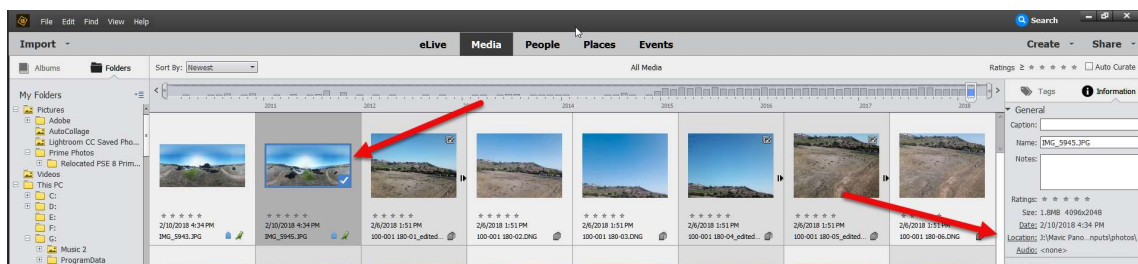


AppTip Sheet – Posting 360 Photos From PC Using 360facebook.com

This is similar to another AppTip Sheet that addresses doing this but using iPad/iPhone browsers, Safari or Chrome. Currently I am having trouble with that approach.

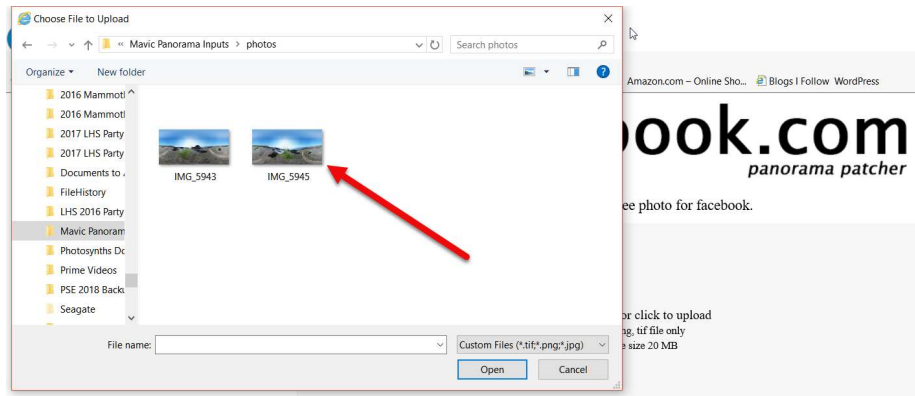
1. Use the Sphere Pano mode in the DJI Go 4 app to take the 360-degree series of photos.
2. Stitch the photos together in the DJI Go 4 app and copy the result to the Camera Roll.
3. Copy the stitched photo to the PC using an appropriate photo transfer program. Below is an example using PSE 2018.



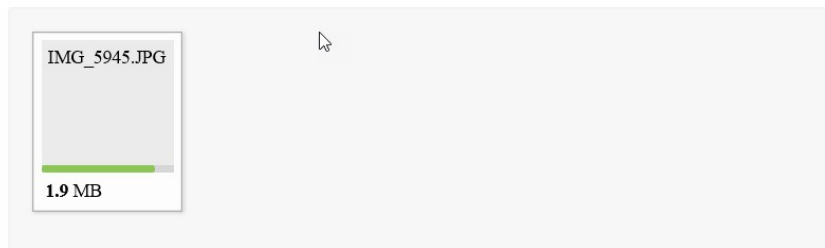
4. Open <http://360facebook.com>.



5. Click where it says to Drop Image...
6. Navigate to the stitched image in Step 3 and upload it. You will see its ID in a square and a progress bar.



How to make 360 degree photo for facebook.



- Once the uploading has completed, **save and rename** the image in the desired folder on the PC.



- Go to Facebook and upload the photo from Step 7 in the normal way. It will be shown as a 360-Photo with the special symbol.
