

## *AppTipSheet – iOS 7 Camera*

This is the standard camera app that comes with iOS 7 for both the iPad and iPhone. Screen shots are from the iPad, but the iPhone is very similar.

### **Basic Screen**

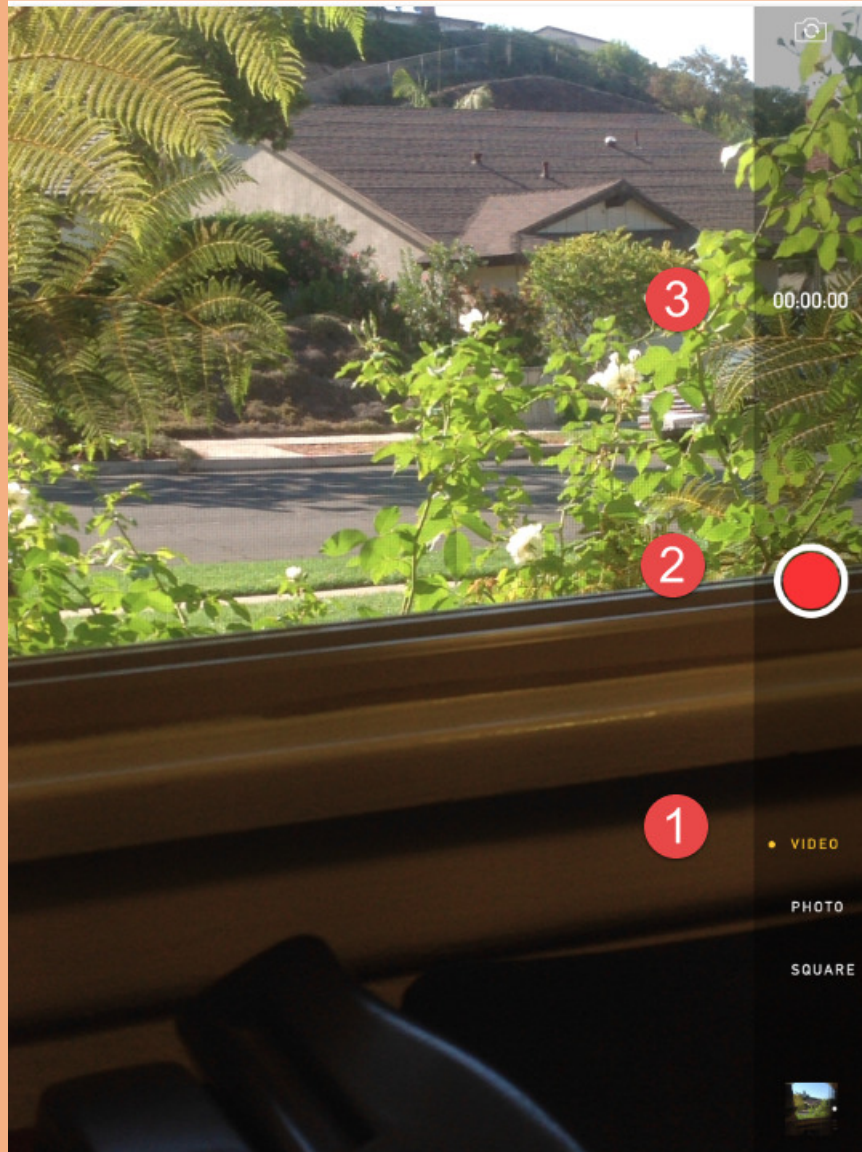


1. Reverse Camera
2. HDR Mode – Yellow When Activated
3. Shutter Button
4. Video Button – Slide Down to Activate. Turns Yellow
5. Single Image – Current Setting
6. Square Image – For Instagram
7. Last Image Taken – Tap to View and Edit

## Taking a Picture or Video

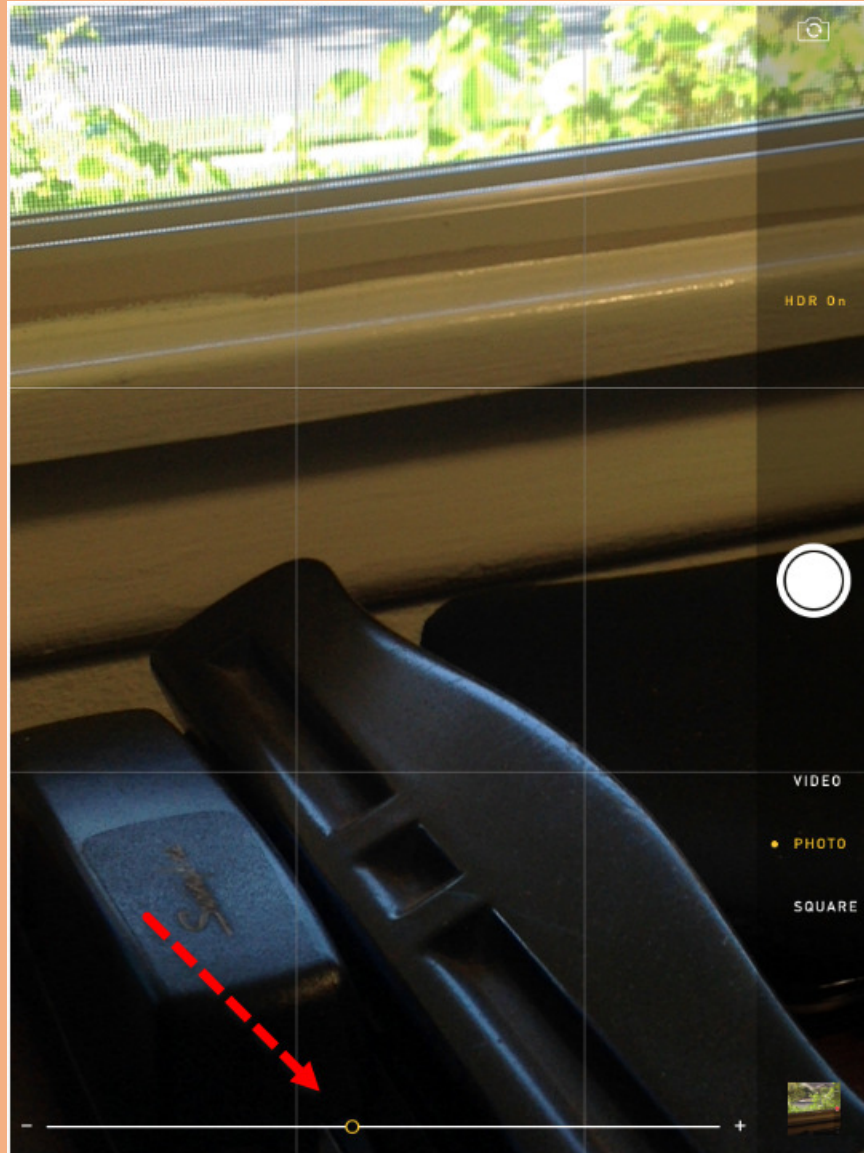
1. Tap on screen where you want the focus and exposure to be set.
2. Tap the Shutter button.

## Screen While Shooting Video



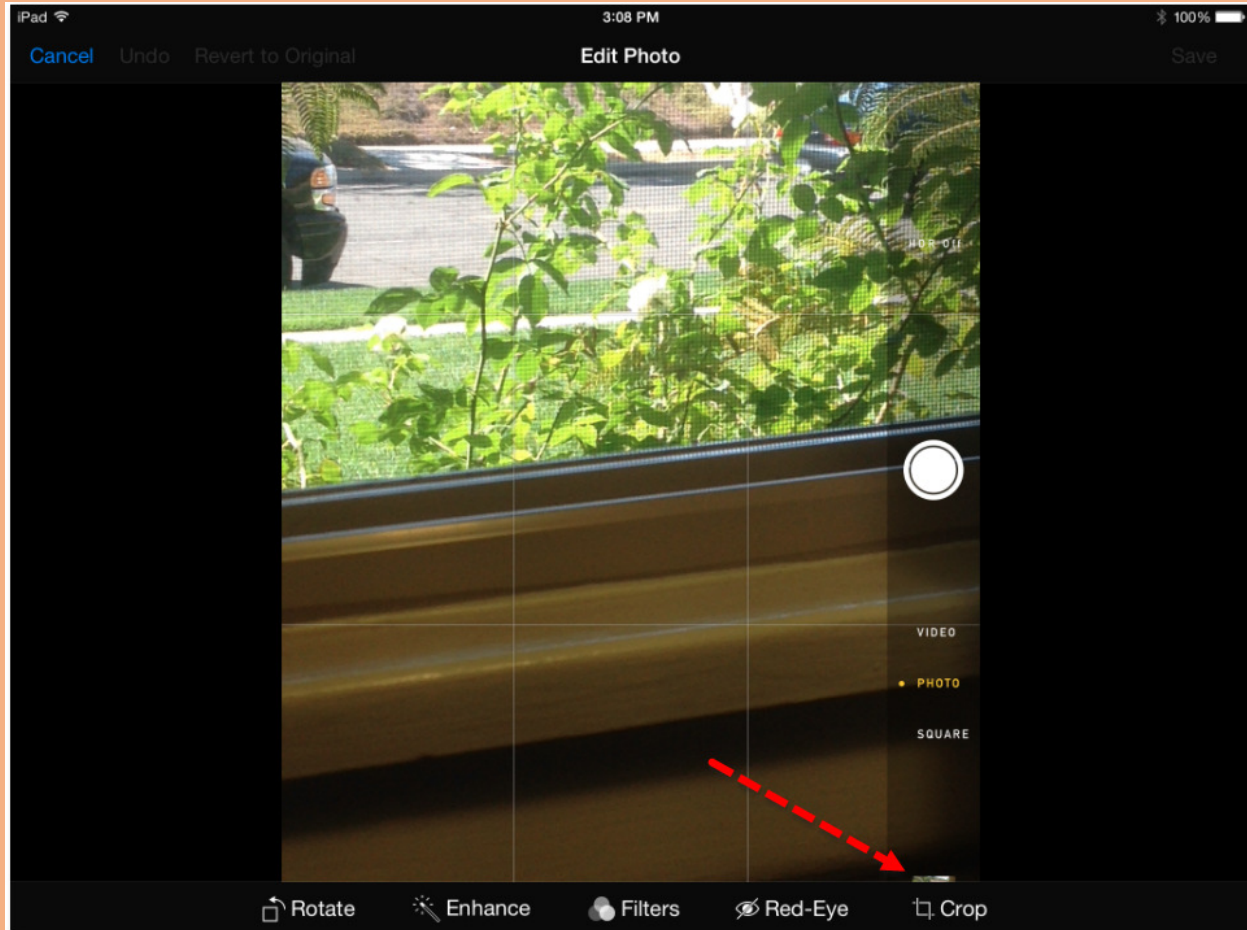
1. Video Mode Set
2. Shutter Button Turns Red While Recording. Tap again to Stop.
3. Recording Time

## Apply Digital Zoom – Lowers Image Quality



1. Pinch fingers to bring up the zoom slider.
2. Swipe the yellow circle to adjust the amount of the zoom.

## To Edit Photo Just Taken



1. Tap on thumbnail in lower right hand corner.
2. Tap on Edit in upper right hand corner.
3. Rotate, Enhance, Filters, Red-Eye, and Crop tools are displayed.
4. Tap on one to begin editing photo.
